**Total pounds collected from the 4 kiosk sites:** 886

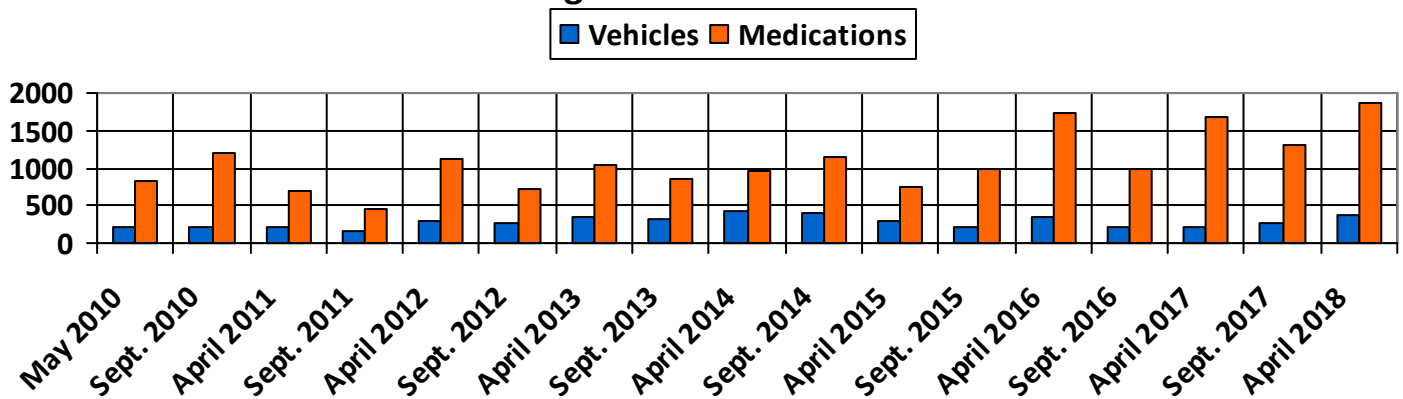
**Total pounds collected since 2010:** 18,383

Access available 24/7 for all 365 days of year.

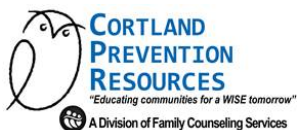
